

CP September Parley To Launch Resolution

The Communist Party discussion now going on will soon enter a new phase, the National Discussion Committee of the Communist Party announced yesterday. "The National Committee of the C.P., following its meeting last April, launched a two-month discussion on the report of Eugene Dennis, Claude Lightfoot, and Max Weiss," the Discussion Committee said. "At that time it was announced that on the completion of the first stage of the discussion the national committee would prepare a draft resolution for the coming national convention. This resolution will be presented at a national conference in September and will be the basis for the pre-convention discussion. In the interim the current discussion will continue.

"There has been a wide and vigorous discussion on all levels of the

party," the National Discussion Committee said. "Naturally in such a discussion as is now taking place there are many different viewpoints on many issues. The National Committee of the C.P. believes that the best and most constructive way for all differences to be presented would be on the basis of the draft resolution to be issued in September. Any major differences in the national leadership in respect to the draft resolution will also be published. This resolution will be based on the National Committee report and the discussion on them and will project perspectives for the party."
