Resolution on the Club proposal for the establishment of a Liaison Committee in Seattle.

Whereas, We hold that a fundamental principle in this period of building a vanguard party is the forging of a single leading ideological center to organize and centralize debate around key political questions facing our movement;

Whereas, The Seattle Club is part of a national process that seeks to place the NNMLC in the center of the party building movement as an ideological center for the movement, thereby undermining unity in the trend;

Whereas, The NNMLC has refused to join in a movement-wide process to build an ideological center and has substituted organizational opportunism for a non-sectarian approach to building such a center,

Whereas, The Seattle Club's proposal for a liaison committee is a shift in tactics but not a shift in their policy to circumvent the OCIC;

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Seattle Local Center of the OCIC rejects their proposal for a liaison committee.
