CANADIAN AND QUEBEC PEOPLE TRIUMPHANTLY CELEBRATE CHINA'S NATIONAL DAY



With raised fists, over 300 members of the broad masses of the Quebec people and foreign friends hail the 21st anniversary of the founding of the People's Republic of China in Montreal on May 4, 1970. They express both their solidarity with China and their love of Chairman Mao.



At the China National Day Celebration in Montreal, October 4, 1970, revolutionary people from Quebec, Canada and other countries respond wholeheartedly to the speech by Comrade Denis Mailloux of the Communist Party of Quebec (Marxist-Leninist). He outlined the brilliant successes achieved by the Chinese people since 1949 and stressed that the Great Proletarian Cultural Revolution has given an iron-clad guarantee that the People's Republic of China will forever be on the side of revolution.

VANCOUVER

October 2nd - Today, one hundred and fifty workers, students and national minorities attended a rally of Friends of China in Vancouver to hail the 21st anniversary of the founding of the People's Republic of China. In the past year, the oppressed nations and peoples, armed with MAO TSETUNG THOUGHT and with Chairman Mao's solemn statement of May 20th, have formed a glorious united front with People's China at the center, to defeat U.S. imperialism once and for all.

A spokesman from Afro-Asian Peoples' Solidarity Movement declared that

China has given strong support to the national liberation struggles of Indo-China, Palestine, Asia, Africa and Latin America, and other countries, and the people of the world have in turn taken up the call of Charu Mazumdar, leader of the Communist Party of India (Marxist-Leninist): CHINA'S PATH IS OUR PATH, CHINA'S CHAIRMAN IS OUR CHAIRMAN! The speaker went on to show that since the Chinese people defeated the Japanese imperialists in 1945, an era in which U.S. imperialism was expanding, and demonstrated the invincibility of People's War, times

SUPPORT FOR PEOPLE'S CHINA GROWS TREMENDOUSLY IN TWO YEARS

Only two years ago in Montreal on October 1st, a small group of twenty people held a warm political celebration of the nineteenth anniversary of the founding of the People's Republic of China. Since that time, through integrating deeply with the broad masses of the Canadian and Quebec people to build political and defense organizations of the working class, conditions have been developed to an entirely new level. This year, only two years after the first and only celebration among Canadians and Quebecois, celebrations were once more held on China's National Day.

This year, however, instead of a handful of people in one city, the Canadian and Quebecois people came out in their thousands from Halifax to Vancouver to hold powerful celebrations of the victories of the heroic Chinese people and to pay homage to their great leader and the leader of all progressive mankind, Chairman Mao Tsetung.

Similar festive celebrations held by patriotic Chinese in Canadian cities have also grown in size and strength.

A huge gala celebration was held in Montreal, the city of the original celebration in 1968. It was sponsored by the Communist Party of Quebec (Marxist-Leninist) and attended by more than 300 enthusiastic members and

supporters of the Party. A similar celebration of 100 people was held in Quebec City.

In Canada, similar celebrations were held in Toronto, Halifax, Ottawa, Regina, Edmonton and Vancouver.

This unprecedented tremendous growth of support for People's China is concrete evidence of the growing revolutionary spirit of the Canadian working class and people, which is becoming stronger and more militant every day. This growth shows that the Canadian people in their thousands are turning toward China and its great helmsman, Chairman Mao Tsetung, for guidance and inspiration in their struggle to emancipate Canada by overthrowing U.S. imperialism and building a new society on the ashes of the old.

Since the earth-shattering success of the Great Proletarian Cultural Revolution and the Ninth National Congress of the Communist Party of China, an unprecedented upsurge of revolutionary strength has shaken imperialism and reaction around the world. The period since these great events in the history of all mankind has seen the formation of bright red Communist Parties in both Canada and Quebec. Since that time, nothing has been able

MONTREAL

On October 4th, 1970, answering the call of the Communist Party of Quebec (Marxist-Leninist), over 300 members of the broad masses of the Quebec people and foreign friends participated in a tumultuous revolutionary rally in support of the People's Republic of China and Chairman Mao. Coming from all parts of Quebec and representing the growing united front led by the Party, the people present commemorated the 21st anniversary of the founding of the People's Republic of China. With great enthusiasm they expressed the confidence that many victories are soon to be won by the whole of progressive mankind.

The great hall was decorated with large colour portraits of Chairman Mao and with the portraits of Marx, Engels, Lenin and Stalin. Banners proclaimed, "Long Live our Great Leader, Mao Tsetung!", "Hail the 21st Anniversary of the People's Republic of China!", "Long live invincible Mao Tsetung Thought!" The re-

volutionary songs, "East is Red" and "Sailing the Seas depends on the Helmsman", greeted the guests as they arrived in the evening. A warm atmosphere of solidarity and friendship existed among the hundreds of people present.

The Chairman opened the meeting and introduced the main speaker, Comrade Denis Mailloux, leading spokesman of the Communist Party of Quebec (Marxist-Leninist). "We meet here," the Chairman declared, "at a time when the world's oppressed people are rising, when China has achieved great victories in the Great Proletarian Cultural Revolution, when China has sent aloft her first satellite, when the United Front of the Indo-Chinese people and the just struggle of the Palestinian people are dealing severe blows against their oppressors, when the closest unity has been established between the world's people and the People's Republic of China and when, for the first time, the Quebec

working class is armed with MAO TSETUNG THOUGHT and with its proletarian party, the COMMUNIST PARTY OF QUEBEC (MARXIST-LENINIST).

Over 100 workers and students gathered at the University of Laval on Friday, October 2nd to celebrate the 21st anniversary of the founding of the Great People's Republic of China. Furthermore, the consolidation of the dictatorship of the proletariat during the Great Proletarian Cultural Revolution has smashed the evil schemes of U.S. imperialism and Soviet social imperialism to liquidate the revolutionary struggles of the world. The counter-revolutionary theories of the Krushchov's of the world of "peaceful co-existence" and "relying on the sensibility of imperialism" have been smashed. Instead the people of all countries have firmly grasped the truth that: **POLITICAL POWER GROWS OUT OF THE BARREL OF A GUN** and that **EVERYTHING REACTIONARY IS THE SAME. IF YOU DON'T HIT IT, IT WON'T FALL.** Today, U.S. imperialism is retreating rapidly and has isolated itself as never before, whereas the people are advancing together on the road to victory. With the detonating of a nuclear weapon and the launching of a satellite by People's China, the nuclear blackmail of the U.S. imperialists and Soviet social imperialists has ended. With the development of the armed agrarian revolution in India, with the developing struggle of the Japanese people against revived militarism, with the ever-deepening unity and struggle of the Indo-Chinese people, all the plots of U.S. imperialism and Soviet social-imperialism to encircle China and attack her, are being foiled. The revolutionary struggles of the 60's have been the preparation for the final struggle; the 70's is the decade of liberation. The speaker concluded by calling upon all the people present to follow Chairman Mao's call: **PEOPLE OF THE WORLD, UNITE AND DEFEAT THE U.S. AGGRESSORS AND ALL THEIR RUNNING DOGS!**

On October 1, 1970, Canadian Friends of China Association in Regina held a revolutionary meeting and social function to commemorate the 21st Anniversary of the People's Republic of China. TORONTO

Over 300 patriotic Chinese resident in Toronto sponsored a celebration in honour of the 21st anniversary of the People's Republic of China. This annual celebration, which began five years ago with a handful of participants, has swelled in size each year, showing the deep and growing pride the Chinese citizens in Canada feel toward their socialist Motherland, and its glowing achievements under the glorious leadership of Chairman Mao Tsetung.

This year, the celebrations lasted a full six hours, beginning at 1:00 p.m. and continuing until after 7 p.m. They were attended by Chinese men and women, young and old, a large contingent of children and a sprinkling of Canadian guests. The celebrants all wore bright red buttons of Mao Tsetung. The programme featured speeches in Chinese in praise of People's China, revolutionary songs, anti-imperialist skits and cultural performances of various kinds. A choir of children sang "We are Chairman Mao's Red Guards". A film of the celebration of China's National Day in Hong Kong last year was shown to warm applause by the participants.

The celebration was followed by a banquet, which was a jubilant success with many toasts and slogans to the Long Life of People's China and its great leader Chairman Mao Tsetung.

OTTAWA

On Friday, October 2, 1970, over one hundred workers and students held an important rally in Ottawa celebrating the 21st Anniversary of the People's Republic of China. The speakers outlined the great successes achieved by the Chinese people under the guidance of Chairman Mao and pledged greater efforts on behalf of the revolutionary people of Canada in class actions against our common enemy.

Representatives from the Syrian community in Ottawa attended the meeting in a resolute show of support for the Chinese people's position on the side of the Arab people in their battle against Israeli Zionism, puppet of the U.S. imperialists; and those who want to sell out the revolutionary struggle of the Arab people by cooking up "peace plans" behind the backs of the people of Palestine.

EDMONTON

Edmonton, Alberta, has been the scene of recent fascist acts of suppression by the Social Credit government there. Four young revolutionaries in Edmonton were held for three months unjustifiably in jail by reactionary courts on trumped up charges of "defamatory libel" which were used as a flimsy cover for naked fascist repression of revolutionary literature. After having served three months in jail, they were released without trial.

In spite of a general atmosphere of repression in Edmonton, 75 people from the city, many from national minorities gathered in the Chinese community to warmly celebrate and hail the 21st anniversary of the founding of the People's Republic of China on October 3rd. The meeting was held in an atmosphere of strength and victory. It was addressed by two patriotic Chinese who gave revolutionary speeches, and by Comrade Roger Trentey, one of the four persecuted comrades, who made a speech representing the Canadian working class. Comrade Trentey pointed out that such a meeting held in Edmonton signifies a great victory for the people, and a real blow to the reactionaries, who hope by means of repression to bring an end to all progressive politics in Edmonton. The meeting showed that all their degenerate attempts are doomed to fail.

Chairman is Our Chairman! China's Path is our Path!", signifying that the Canadian and Quebec people have begun their forward march in history.

Side by side with the development of support for People's China, the anti-imperialist revolution of the Canadian people has surged forward to an entirely new stage.

Mary Hoffman Must Not Be Deported

The latest attack by the Immigration Department is a deportation order against a young worker, Mary Hoffman. Her "appeal" on September 8th before the Immigration Department Tribunal was turned down. Mary was arrested in Toronto for taking part in the May 9th demonstration against U.S. aggression in Indo-China. She was sentenced to 90 days in jail. Mary has always taken a militant and uncompromising stand outside and inside the courtroom and faithfully defended the true interests of the Canadian people. Immigration law provides that "aliens" convicted of "criminal" offenses may be deported. In practice this law is used as a cover for political repression of foreign-born and national minority activists who dare to stand beside the Canadian people in opposing a common enemy, U.S. imperialism.

Mary was born in Germany and has lived in several countries since, always with her parents. She came to Canada in 1965 with her parents and went to high school here. Mary met the Canadian Student Movement in 1969 and from then on devoted herself to the anti-imperialist struggle of the Canadian people. She is a staunch supporter of the Communist Party of Canada (Marxist-Leninist). After leaving high school, Mary resolutely decided to integrate with the working people and went to work in an electrical plant near Kitchener, Ontario where she took part in various struggles for the right to organize. She recently married Eric Hoffman, who is also under threat of deportation. She is expecting a child. Mary has no roots or even legal status in any other country. Her family and all her contacts are in Canada. Mary's parents are citizens of the so-called "Polish Government in Exile", an attempt by Polish landowners to keep the myth alive that they still own Poland. This "government" controls no territory and is located in England. It has neither diplomatic status in England nor in Canada. The Canadian government has no basis for deporting her, not even in terms of their own "legality".

MEETING IN REGINA

Mary Hoffman was invited to speak in Regina on Monday, October 5th in a rally to DEFEND THE RIGHT OF FOREIGN-BORN IN OUR COUNTRY TO OPPOSE U.S. IMPERIALISM. The rally was sponsored by the Regina Anti-Fascist Cultural Studies Group and the Student's Representative Council of the University of Saskatchewan at Regina Campus.

As soon as the people in Regina read in PEOPLE'S CANADA DAILY NEWS about Mary Hoffman's case against the order of the Immigration Department to deport her for her political activity of opposing the U.S. imperialist domination of Canada and fighting for the democratic rights of the Canadian people against fascist repression, the Regina Anti-Fascist Cultural Studies Group wrote PEOPLE'S CANADA DAILY NEWS a letter expressing their resolute support for Mary's right to remain in Canada. The letter reported that at the Regina Campus many students demanded that agitation start immediately denouncing the fascist policies of the Immigration Department and opposing political deportations. The letter added that the students were talking about setting up an anti-deportation committee.

Since September 26th when agitation first began in Regina, the students have been true to their word. They have organized staunch support for Mary's case and in opposition to all political deportations.

On Thursday, October 1st, progressive students and members of the Student's Representative Council passed two motions in the council meeting. The first resolves that letters will be sent to the Immigration Department expressing the total disapproval of the students of these cases involving political deportations. The students at the same time said that letters would also be sent to opposition parties and different levels of government. The second motion passed agreed to fly Mary to Regina from Toronto in order that she speak to the students about her case, thereby using her case as an instrument to awaken the Canadian people to oppose the anti-people atrocities committed by the Immigration department and win more support for her right to remain in Canada.

The Regina Anti-Fascist Cultural Studies Group, co-sponsor of the rally, immediately circulated a leaflet denouncing the Immigration department and mobilizing support for Mary's case. The leaflet emphasized that "with the rising tide of anti-imperialist sentiment in Canada, we find the state apparatus being used to repress those who are a threat to the U.S. domination of our country. Here in Regina we have seen that Cana-

dian patriots who took part in a demonstration against the U.S. imperialist Army Field Band were charged with "taking part in a riot."

The leaflet continues: "The fascist Report of the Royal Commission on Security, published in a censored form in June 1969, is a blatant attack on the fundamental democratic and political rights of the Canadian people to organize to overthrow their oppressors, using whatever means necessary. This report takes for granted that it is in the interest of the Canadian people to defend U.S. imperialism: 'The United States is the leader of the western allies in terms of military economic and political power... it is in the Canadian national interest to assist with the defence of North America against threats to internal security.'" (p.9) The Canadian colonial government therefore "welcomes" into Canada pro-imperialist foreigners, like major U.S. investors and reactionaries of various hues and colours. Progressive people opposed to U.S. imperialism are being denied entry to Canada and landed immigrant status here. Recently the RCMP "escorted" American deserters, legally in Canada, back across the border and into the imperialist jails."

The leaflet continued with examples of many more anti-imperialist fighters in Canada and Quebec who have been or are being deported to the United States for their progressive activities here.

The leaflet ends by pointing out that "following the example of the McCarthy period in the U.S., the Canadian government, in their vain attempt to prevent the development of anti-imperialist revolution altogether, is giving itself the right to deport anyone who denounces their activities in selling out our country to the U.S. By this tactic the Canadian comprador bourgeoisie as they did in the 1919 Winnipeg General Strike, tries to pin the "blame" for working class and student uprisings on "aliens" and "outsiders".

"At the beginning of this year the government was forced to back down from its attempts to deport Kwok Wing Lai, a Chinese student at the University of Manitoba, whom they were trying to expel for his political activities. A protest raised by the people all across Canada caused the Immigration department and courts to retreat."

The activities of the students in Regina are a clear reflection of the anti-fascist sentiment of the Canadian people. Their support at the present time for the right of Mary Hoffman to remain in Canada shows that masses of people in increasing numbers are standing up to fight on the basis of what is right and what is wrong.

AFRO-ASIAN MEETING ON PALESTINE

VANCOUVER

The Afro-Asian People's Solidarity Movement held the first of three revolutionary meetings at the University of British Columbia on October 1st to express their firm solidarity with the just cause of the Palestinian people. The Chairman stated in his opening speech that the AAPSM is the staunch supporter of the national liberation struggles of the world's people and that the struggle of the Palestinian people is part of the world-wide struggle against U.S. imperialism and Soviet social imperialism.

The first speaker, a Palestinian, dealt briefly with the history of the Palestinian people since 1948 against the Zionist aggressors. He exposed the role played by the British and the French imperialists in selling out the interests of the Palestinian people to the Zionists and the role of the U.S. imperialists in plundering their Homeland and encouraging the Zionists to commit atrocities against the people. The speaker emphasized that now the Palestinian people have stood up and are reigning one blow after the other against their Zionist enemies and that the people of the whole world are supporting them. The speaker vowed: "I will never forget the crimes of the British, French and U.S. imperialists. They are like wolves. When a dog dies on the street, the imperialists raise a hue and cry about 'inhumane treatment', but when they massacred our people and drove them off their Homeland they did not utter a peep."

The second speaker, also a Palestinian, exposed the basis of Zionism as being racism and fascism. He clearly showed that the Zionists justify their aggressive acts of throwing the Palestinian people off their land by preying on the sentiments of the Jewish people and their long struggle against religious and racial persecution, portraying the just struggle of the Palestinian people against Zionism

cont. from page 2, "SUPPORT GROWS" struggle in 1968 was discussion among small groups. Today, however, mass democracy is a regular occurrence in many cities. A vigorous resistance movement is flourishing throughout Canada.

A speaker from the Communist Party of Canada (Marxist-Leninist), addressing a rally in Toronto reminded his listeners that the Communist Party of China, when it was a new party in a large and populous nation, held its first Congress in 1921 with fewer delegates than attended some of the meetings in Canada this week. He said that by holding to the faith that they represented the aspirations of the broad masses of the Chinese people, the Communist Party was able to win victory after victory until the final victory of revolution in 1949. He said that with the present day support for revolution in Canada, the excellent unity of the world's people coming up under China's leadership, and the great power of Mao Tsetung Thought, the revolution of the Canadian people is assured of success.

Since 1968, an entirely new spirit has been born among the people of Can-

ada, he said, a spirit of all-out resistance to U.S. imperialism and its lackeys. This spirit is represented by heroes of the Canadian working class and people like Comrade Robert A. Cruise, the leading spokesman of the Communist Party of Canada (Marxist-Leninist) who dared to take a shotgun to defend a progressive bookstore from fascist attacks. In serious protest against the "charges" trumped up against him, and in protest against the fascist courts, he has persisted ever since September 20th in a starvation strike in jail. The speaker said that such a militant spirit of sacrifice and resistance would be impossible in the world today without the inspiring example of the Chinese people to follow, and without the tremendous unifying power of Mao Tsetung Thought, which is uniting the world's people in a united front to defeat U.S. imperialism and fascism everywhere. It is for these reasons, he said, that the Canadian people join together every October 1st to celebrate China's victories with the deepest gratitude and honour toward the leader of all the progressive nations and people in the world.
