Dear branch organizers:

The international subcommittee is being reorganized to prepare ourselves for the work for the next year. The convention mandated that our major activity will be around support for the revolution in Southern Africa. We have started working out our perspectives, and we will need some help from the branches as well.

1) SEPTEMBER 11 is the date for the South Africa cadre school. We would like all branch organizers in the mid-west and east coast to talk to your branches, districts as to who should go. The cadre school is similar to the Portugal cadre school we held last year; branch organizers and those comrades who were going to carry out the international work should attend. We hope that most of the Black comrades will come; branch organizers etc. There will be 7 talks about South Africa and Namibia; Zimbabwe; Angola and the MPLA; national self determination; permanent revolution; American imperialism; organizing our work. We are also going to show the film Last Grave at Dimbaza. So again, please save the date, and please start talking with members of your branch about who is to come.

The purpose of the school will be to organize our members to both speak and write about the revolution in Southern Africa and what it means for socialist revolution and the Black liberation struggle.
