

SUMMER CONFERENCE

Mark your calendar for the weekend of June 28-29. There will be an I.S. weekend conference in Brighton, Michigan at the Emerich Conference Center. It is the same facility that last year's successful women's conference was held at. There are comfortable sleeping facilities, catered food, lovely grounds and swimming nearby.

The political committee steering committee has begun discussion on the content of the weekend. This letter is being sent out to solicit further suggestions, ideas and information on what people would like to see at the conference.

The idea behind the conference is to provide a relaxed atmosphere far away from telephones and tension filled meetings to discuss where the I.S. is at, what is happening in the world, the political scene in the U.S., the prospects for the revolutionary left and where the I.S. fits into the developments of the 1980's.

Tentative plans also include substantive workshops on issues and topics specific to the areas of work we are presently involved in or facing in our political work (i.e. political lessons of TDU, building an anti-imperialist movement that can take on both United States and Soviet imperialism, the democratic party, third party politics and the Citizen's Party, urban populism, energy questions, etc.). To make this weekend successful feedback is necessary to insure the content and organization of the conference is enjoyable, relevant and informative.

There will be plenty of time scheduled for relaxation so plan to have fun. Probable cost will be \$25 per adult, which will cover from Saturday morning through late Sunday afternoon, including all meals. People will be encouraged to arrive Friday evening for a night of socialization and enjoyment. People will then proceed to Brighton the next morning.

Parents, we need to know the following. Will you be bringing your children (there will be somewhat of a reduced rate for children) or would you prefer arrangements to be made in Detroit that weekend or do you prefer to make your own arrangements? We must know this as soon as possible to properly plan to insure the well being of your children and their respective happiness.

While this is primarily a weekend for I.S. members contacts and friends of the organization are of course invited. It will be a fun, relaxed weekend that anyone interested in our ideas would surely enjoy.

We need to know by the end of April-early May how many people are planning to come so we can properly arrange the facilities to guarantee a good time for all. We realize this letter requests information for an event several months away but if it is to be successful we need your participation and cooperation early in the game.
