MOTION PASSED BY IMT BUREAU (ONE ABSTENTION)

- 1) To approve the general line of the report given by comrade Amin.
- 2) To have the draft "For the Dissolution of the IMT; For the Strengthening of the International" edited by the IMT members of the Bureau of the United Secretariat and sent out to all IMT Steering Committee members (IMT members of the IEC).
- 3) To send all contributions of IMT Steering Committee members to the IMT Steering Committee.
- 4) To call an IMT Steering Committee meeting for November 1, after the meeting of the United Secretariat, with one point on the agenda: discussion of the draft document and vote on this document.
- 5) To propose to the Steering Committee that all non-IMT members of the United Secretariat be invited to attend the IMT Steering Committee meeting.
- 6) To send <sup>+</sup> comrade Pola, secretary of the Bureau of the United Secretariat and member of the IMT, at this meeting with voice.

STATEMENT BY WINNIE

I am for the dissolution of the IMT.

1) I did abstain in the vote on the first paragraph, because I don't know the real content of the dissolution text. I have written a critical text to the European Document of 1972/1974 and the IMT proposal for a new European document, which was presented in autumn of 1975. This text is not known to the majority of the IMT Steering Committee members. Otherwise, I don't know the new draft for a European document. This means that I don't know if either in the dissolution text nor in the European document text my criticisms or parts of it are integrated.

2) I am against the presence of non-IMT members at the IMT meeting for the dissolution of the tendency. Although I personally support a dissolution and it seems to be evident that the IMT will be dissolved (perhaps or probably unanimously), I think this will give a bad example and gave one in the case of the LTF meeting. The discussion on such an important question should be absolutely free of any potential pressure. Another story is that after the dissolution all texts -- majority and minority -- should be published.
