

## Report on Jean Dube's Tour

### Detroit

Jean had a very successful meeting at Wayne State U. with 140 people in attendance. Broad sponsorship including a number of young lawyers had been obtained for the meeting. 27 people signed sponsor cards, 31 added their names to a mailing list, and \$76 was collected.

A Sunday brunch meeting was held with a group of young lawyers and others interested in working on the committee. One of the lawyers expressed interest in observing the trials which were scheduled to begin in early Sept. in Paris.

Dube was interviewed on the Lou Gordon TV show.

The press conference had to be cancelled because of changes in Jean's plane schedule. The press had been very anxious to interview him.

### Seattle

Jean spoke at a very successful forum.

### Bay Area

The Bay Area was able to get very good press coverage. There was wide press representation at a press conference held at the San Francisco headquarters. Articles appeared in the S.F. Examiner and the Chronicle. Dube was also interviewed by KPFA radio, the S.F. Express Times, the Mid-Peninsula Observer, the Berkeley Barb, and appeared on the A.M. TV show.

67 people attended the S.F. forum. Over 20 sponsors were obtained. The collection netted \$23 and \$40 was obtained at a party following the forum.

\$20 and more than 25 sponsors were obtained at the forum in Berkeley.

### Los Angeles

Dube had two radio interviews on KPFFK - one half hour broadcast in French and the other an hour long interview.

Sat. night the YSA sponsored the most successful party it's held in L.A. About 50 people attended and \$60 was collected.

80 people attended a Sunday Militant Labor Forum and a collection of \$115 was taken. About 30 people sponsored the committee.

### Chicago

\$40.59 was collected at a forum of 50 to 60 people.

Jean had a good discussion with SDS national leaders in Chicago,

A TV station interviewed Dube.

New York

Jean spoke to 20 students at Columbia U. 10 of them were Gaullists and a lively discussion followed Jean's presentation.

AP, France-Amerique (a newspaper in French sold in the U.S.) and the French Press Agency were represented at a press conference. France-Amerique carried an article on Dube.

WBAI radio interviewed Jean.

130 people attended a Militant Labor Forum Fri. night and over \$150 was collected for the defense work.
