Dear Comrades,

The next issue of the Young Socialist, the May issue, will be available for the April 15 mobilization. It will contain articles on the YSA convention, the East Coast and Mid-West socialist conferences, the victory in the Bloomington case, and an article on independent political action. A bundle order form is enclosed. Please return this immediately, by March 20, as part of the YS will go to press before the convention.

This issues will be the first one since the decision by the NEC to go on a monthly schedule at a less expensive price. The May issue will sell for 15¢. Further details of the changes in the YS will be gone over at the convention.

Locals should sell the current issue, the February-March issue on the busses, trains and whatever that will be coming to New York and San Francisco. The May issue will be sold on the March itself, and locals can pick up their bundles at the mobilization in San Francisco and New York.

Locals will continue to receive a 20% discount for bundles (12¢ a copy). Newsstand discounts will also remain at their current rate--40%, or 9¢ a copy.
