"Thanks to Ebert," says Prishane, "to the highly intelligent and scientifically trained German specialists, and the millions of German workers, educated for 40 years in the social-democratic party, the Germans have the power of self-government.

"Their administration has stood firm, ever since the war, under most horribly trying conditions. That is the greatest possible tribute to the self-governing power of the Germans. And Ebert will be honored in history as the loyal servant of German democracy."

Brisbane gets near to the truth with his final thought. All the rest is bunk. Ebert will be honored as a loyal servant of "German democracy," camouffage for "German democracy," camouffage for "German capitalism." Ebert and his fellow social-democrats exerted most of their strength thru the trade unions and the social-democratic party built up in the period of "peace" before the world war started.
