

Two German Bankers on Visit to Morgan's Wall St.: Workers May Prophesy

By J. LOUIS ENGDAHL

TODAY, a couple of German bankers wander thru New York's canyon of gold, called Wall Street, where eight years ago the great American Jingo tumult as the United States entered the war crystallized into three words, "Kill the Huns,"

No greater proof is needed that Morgan's Wall Street won the war, insofar as any capitalist nation was victorious, than the confession of these two bankers that, "the uncovened king of Germany today is S. Parker Clibert, the American who is carrying out the Dawes plan."

This was of course intended as a tribute to the genius of American financiers. But it tells the story better than whole books. The Germans had come to acknowledge their victors and to do homage to them.

But the Carman bankers found many friends in Wall Street. Morgan entered the United States in the war to save his loans to the allies. Now he must keep the Dawes plan working in Germany to get the very last mark in reparations possible, the sagerness with which American bankers receive their German brothers is the best measure of the unity of the German American bankers alliance to exploit the work of Berlin, and presented as "a director in 40 of German's Largest industrial corporations," and F. Neusrburg, director of the Kommerz- and Privatbank A-Co. So the German bankers had better make themselves at home in Wall Street and sun themselves at the National Republican Club while they may.
