NRA AS CLUB EMPHASIZED BY RICHBERG

Calls Extension of Act Weapon Against Class Struggle

Richberg, director of the National Emergency Council, today gave the Senate Finance Committee the Roosevelt administration's specific proposals for extending the N.R.A. as a weapon against what he bluntly identified—"class struggle."

Blessing company unionism and monopolistic price-fixing, Richberg was the first witness before the Administration-controlled Senate Committee in hearings in which the Blue Eagle law will be re-written...

In typical Hitler style Richberg attempted to wait aside the existence of the class struggle and at the same time deliberately invoked it as the threat against which...

He asserted it is "still worthwhile" to follow "this program," rather than "to accept the alternative of class struggle for political domination."

He outlined this program in seventeen points including substantial...
