Brewery Workers Get Big Increase

A million dollar increase in wages for the brewery workers of Milwaukee for the next three years has been conceded by the brewers.

This was the announcement that followed a joint conference in the majestic building Sunday night when the brewery workers' executive board told the employers that an overwhelming majority of the members of the unions had voted during the day in favor of a strike rather than the acceptance of the proposition submitted by the employers.

An agreement was then drawn which practically grants the first demands of the unions, and which is expected to be endorsed by the unions at a mass meeting to be arranged probably Tuesday afternoon, after which the agreement will be signed and go into effect immediately.
