BERLIN, Germany, Dec. 24.—The Nazi court at Leipzig, seeing its frame-up thoroughly exposed as evident from the worldwide protests, was forced to bring in a verdict of not guilty for the four Communists on trial, charged with burning the Reichstag. The Nazi tool, Van Der Lubbe, was the only one found guilty and condemned to hang.

Six Months of Roosevelt Economics

December 10th marked six months since the NRA was introduced. The 'New Deal' as a whole is now about 10 months old. It is therefore appropriate to take stock of the results.

It is estimated that over 200,000 other methods through the NRA to the big banks and corporations. This compares with \$400,000,000 for the CWA jobs for the 17,000,000 unemployed.

According to Relief Administrator Hopkins, this winter we started with 1,000,000 more on the relief rolls than last year. The number of families prior to the CWA jobs, on relief rose to 3,000,000.

As far as wages are concerned, the government depends on the figures issued by the A. F. of L. The A. F. of L. officials, the staunchest supporters of the NRA, can be depended upon for painting the brightest picture possible.

The Roosevelt administration has made crop destruction and a permanent policy of the U. S. government. Taxes on reaching a billion are levied on the most staple products, chiefly consumed by the poor, to make a fund out of which to pay to those who destroy.

As far as the West is concerned we get even a gloomier picture. Employment in California declined by 10.2% in November. The general business index for the West States which reached 64% of the 1929-30 level, has declined to 58.4% in October and is probably somewhere near the March low of 53.4% by now.

The facts above are in a far more showing manner the same policy that prevailed under Hoover. It will not make for raising the buying power, but on the contrary will aggravate the crisis. In the National City Bank report, the NRA is described as carrying through in a far more showing manner the same policy that prevailed under Hoover.

Government Admits U. S. Schools Being Destroyed

Long lines of teachers stand in C. W. A. offices, waiting to fill out registration blanks for jobs. School teachers, like other American workers, wait, wait, for jobs.

Recently the Office of Education at Washington has issued a pamphlet called "The Deepening Crisis in Education". It can be obtained from the U. S. government printing office for five cents.

This fall nearly 2,000 rural schools in 21 States failed to open. 2,280,000 American children of school age ought to be in school but are not.

16 institutions of higher learning have been discontinued since last year. 1,500 commercial schools and colleges have closed.

In some communities, free public schools have disappeared; tuition is charged, and only the children whose parents can afford to pay can go to school.

25,000 teachers have been dropped, while a million more pupils have come into the schools. 200,000 certificated teachers are unemployed.

And the federal report says the worst is still to come! In Michigan, 90% of the schools will cut at least 1 month.

Christmas Did Not Stop Unemployment Drop

SAN FRANCISCO, Jan. 18.—The stimulating effects of Christmas buying and his expenditure of the first WA checks, Frank C. Macdonald in his report for December, shows that employment in California decreased by 4.5% in comparison with November, and the payrolls total decreased by 2.7%. He reports an increase in the average earnings for each worker, by 1.9%.
