

## Cameroon: recent guerrilla operations

In less than 7 days, the fascist Ahidjo finished his lightning helicopterborne tour of Foumban, Bafoussan and Munga. He even made a stop at Yaoundé, a place he had not set foot in since he assumed power in Yaoundé. We would be foolish to believe that this was an ordinary visit being made by a chief of State to his citizens. In our New Year's message to the people of the Cameroons we reaffirmed our steadfast determination to carry the revolutionary struggle to its final consequences. Making this unquenchable determination a reality, our soldiers went into action immediately. On January 2, in Bason (NDE) a "self-defense" chief was put out of action and his weapon was captured by the ALNK. The



same day, in Duchang, a spy was killed. On January 8 and 26 in Upper NKAM, our units repelled a violent enemy counterattack inflicting casualties on them, including one officer killed and several soldiers killed and wounded. On February 25, in reprisal for the assassination of a people's soldier by counterrevolutionary elements, the ALNK took their encampment at Bancks (MIFI) by assault. This resulted in four killed and several wounded. In Kakan, on April 2, a "self-defense soldier" was killed and his weapon captured. Our comrades pasted our leaflets all over the place during these operations. All these blows dealt by the ALNK which the comrades of Mham, Mungo and other places are emulating, have created real panic among the ruling puppet circles. This is the reason for the decision made by Ahidjo, their chieftan, to personally undertake a campaign to counteract the guerrilla actions in the "trouble spots." Thus the puppet Ahidjo's tour was made for military reasons.
