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EDITORIAL

Nigeria, Tanzania, the Organisation of African Unity are the most distressing examples leading to the reunion of all sons of Africa.

Thus we of UDENAMO understand that only UNITY can make us strong. We recognize that all Mozambicans must pull together. And that is the reason why we wish all Mozambican political parties to consider the possibilities of reunion and try their best to accomplish it. We heartily hope their efforts will come to a constructive solution and UNITY will be brought out for the benefit of the Mozambican struggle, of all colonies under Portuguese domination, of the African Unity and of the Human Rights everywhere in the World.

OUR FORCES INSIDE MOZAMBIQUE

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There is no doubt-that soon or later Mozambique nationalist movements, will be forced by their followers, to form a <u>COMMON ACTION FRONT</u>, if the fighting forces will continue waging the struggle in common, as they did at 25th September uprising, where by the militants of the two nationalist movements, UDENAMO and FRELIMO fought together.

We learnt with great satisfaction that during this uprising, they claimed thousands militants of FRELIMO, where under the command of Lucas Fernandes, a member of UDENAMO, who is now launguishing in Portuguese prison, and since the arrest of Fernandes, has never saliented any one as head of the continuing fight, among the thousands of Mondlane's trainees.

It will be waste of time and creation of mislead to our people and the world as well, if we try to find out, among the two nationalist movements who conducted and who is conducting the fight. We are all aware of the fact that, since Tanganyika achieved its independence, the Portuguese government have been endeavouring by all means to strengthen its borders in the Northern of Mozambique, being Tanganyika, the first country to achieve independence among all countries bordering with Mozambique. Also in our plans of fighting we are not to wage a full scale war, but a guerilla warfare, thus we sent through all possible channels of penetration a reasonable number of militants capable to infiltrate without the sight of the enemy, equal to that hearded by Lucas Fernandes composed of ten men.

We in UDENAMO, as unity lovers and as we fully believe that the unumbered nationalist movements of Mozambique are all fighting for the same cause and beside the fact that it is well known that, the borders between Tanganyika and Mozambique, besides natural difficulties caused by the River Rovuma is also closely patrolled by the Portuguese troops since the proclamation of the independence of Tanganyika. We do not deny that FRELIMO has sent thousands militants into Mozambique through Tanganyika border, though we are aware of the fact that FRELIMO does not possess the claimed number of militants. As long as they will not also deny the existence of our forces inside Mozambique, because if they do so, it will be a surprise that the 25th September uprising that, the FRELIMO militants who were fighting, were under the command of Lucas Fernandes, a member of UDENAMO with his NINE MEN.

Unity has been advocated by the ten UDENAMO and thousand FRELIMO militants, who, inspite of the differences caused by the different nationalist movement, they demonstrated unity at the 25th uprising and their are still fighting side by side, this is an example to the leaders of the two nationalist movements, who, because of their foolish differences, are dividing the people and back-holding the struggle. Following the recent uprising and considering the danger of any clash of our forces in side the country, UDENAMO instructed all its militants to mantain co-operation with FRELIMO militants and others from various organisation in cauge they may be also in the field; wherever they meet.

Finally, we would like to make it clear, to those who, because of their lack of understanding or because of their foolish different vision on the importance of unity, that our militants, whom our fight lies on, have already demonstrated to us that, unity, in what form it may come, it is the unique means, through which we can easily achieve our goal of independence. Therefore, UDENAMO, strongly request on the behalf of the seven million toiling masses for an immediate burying of all these unreasonable differences and realise the crucial time of our struggle.

According the press interview given by Mr.Peter Simbi the supposed acting president of the Mozambique African National Congress (MANC), to the ZAMBIA STAR 12th November, which stated that the three Mozambican Nationalist Organisation based in Lusaka namely UDENAMO, FRELIMO and MANC are continuing disagree on the question of forming a common front against the Portuguese oppression in Mozambique. And that top officials of the three parties have been urged to unite by UNIP Secretary for Pan-African Affairs Mr.Banda, but they are showing no willingness to burry their differences!!

In the name of the Mozambique National Democratic Union (UDENAMO), I would like to make it clear to Mr.Simbi that his statement in the press of rejecting the unity of all Mozambicam patriotic forces does not represent the views of other parties mentioned nor those of the oppressed people of Mozambique.

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If Mr. Simbi does not know the meaning of unity, which we very much desire, he should just remain silent rather than keep on misleading the people of Mozambique.

We of UDENAMO, are not particularly surprised by his actions, of endeavouring to undermine the efforts being done of trying to unite all Mozambican political parties. We of UDENAMO, are aware of the cordial treatment which the Mozambican African National Congress is afforded by the white minority regime headed by Smith and his thugs, in Rhodesic, while the genuine leaders of Zimbabwe are languishing in restriction and their parties banned, while thousands innoncent African men Women and children are undergoing the most inhuman treatmenta in their own country of birth, and our members are being arrested and Sent back to Mozambique day after day. He should also bear in mind that all Mozambique political parties save his party are banned in Rhodesia. This however, does not discourage us from this task of trying to unite our forces.

On the 12th of November the S.R.Chief Justice Sir Hugh Beadle ruled out that Mr.Joshua Nkomo the President of ZAPU and 16 others are being illegaly held in detention in Gwelo Prison.

The announcement of the Judgement really shocked Smith, whon since his government was elected into office by the white settlers of Rhodesia, has been applying jungle laws to crush the spirit of nationalism in Zimbabwe. But the fact is that, what ever methods Smith government can apply, will not deter the sons and daughters of Zimbabwe from fighting for their goal of independence in their land of their ancestors.

After hearing the announcement of the judgement, and through fear of the release of Nkomo, Smith automatically announced that he has restricted President Joshua Nkomo for another four years ato Gonakudzingwa.

This miscariage of justice, which Smith is applying will not benefit his government in any way. The will of the majority and their deside to attain their goal of independence will lead them to victory, what ever comes. Smith cannot resist or stop the wind of change which is blowing in the continent of Africa. Whether Smith can use all his tactics to delay the independence of Zimbabwe, the fact is that they will accomplish their goal of independence.

ONE PARTY SYSTEM.

Africa is on its toad of no return toward AFRICAN UNITY, which is the foster of the future well-being and peace in the African Continent. In order to achieve this great dream, it is necessary that the question of having unnecessary oppositions have to be ruled out in a good understanding, especially in countries which have achieved their independence.

AND_WHAT_ABOUT_THE_WAGES:

The Portuguese law regarding the so-called "Over-seas Province" of Mozambique and every other Portuguese colony is strongly anti-segregation and boastly integrational. But this is what the law rules... on papers. Because the reality is on the other ened, I mean on the opposite end of the line.

As a matter of fact the man-in-street knows only that he is as much as a fellow citizen and that he may go to Gil Vicente of Manuel Rodrigues (the best showhouses in Lourenco Marques) or to any first class restaurant, beerhall or resthouse if he wants to And here is the irony of the situation; wants what? And then the reason to ask: and what about the WAGES... sorry, the African WAGES?

Because dear reader I must stress that in ninety cases out of a hundred, the Mozambican man-in-street is an African; Coloureds, poor Indians and Chinese make about seven per cent and the remaining 3% consists of poor Portuguese <u>white</u>"colonos", but at the agricultural region of the Limpopo Dam, the word is already appering in official papers reffered to African farmers. This is the reason why we underlined the expression white "colonos". This may seem a semantical Babel to our readers but that isn't the Portuguese point of view, whose only purpose is show to the world " the harmony of the multiracial portuguese community, where there is no discrimination of religion" (everybody is a catholic by birth) or political creeds (fascism is the only policy). But to call an African a settler is too much of c's' w isn't it?

Anyway let's go back to the wages.

The avarage African worker whether is a panelbeater, bricklayer or any other, earns in most cases, less than half the wages of his fellow white, coloured of Asiatic worker. Nepotism (remember the government is 100% white, thus all protection and preference go to the whites) is the word of order. And the very few Africans who have the privilege of earning up to £80 or £100 a month are either spies or people who, through gifts and favours seek the attention

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and protection of a top-job holding Portuguese. In both cases the African must be a stooge. And we all know stooges are the worst enemies of rising nationalism.

So who wants to go to places and enjoy life? And who doesn't want to? but who really <u>can</u> do so? Only those whose income admits such Luxury, and these are the Portuguese. Where the paradox: Bortuguese multiracialism, because it denies the economical side is as bad or even worse than Verwoerd's apartheid.

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
