PARTY COMMITTEE AT POSTS AND TELECOMMUNICATIONS SCHOOL ATTACKED

[A handwritten, undated, handbill issued by the Revolutionary Rebel Corps, Cultural Revolution Provisional Committee, Northwest Posts and Telecommunications School, entitled "What Kind of Commodity Is the Red Long-March 2nd Corps," reads as follows:]

[Text] Supreme Directive: Everything reactionary is the same; if you don't hit it, it won't fall. This is also like sweeping the floor; as a rule, where the broom does not reach, the dust will not vanish of itself.

The former Cultural Revolutionary Preparatory Committee and Red Long-March Corps of the Northwest School of Posts and Telecommunications had been notorious for their royalist and revisionist nature. They eventually were done away with on 11 January. Coming in their wake, the Red Long-March 2nd Corps is a pig of the same litter. It is formed by the iron-rod royalists of the former Cultural Revolution Preparatory Committee and is a brother of the Red Long-March Corps. This Red Long-March Corps is a "royalist corps." This 2nd Corps is actually an "iron-rod royalist corps" and a second escapist corps!

When the broad masses of revolutionary teachers and students of our Provisional Committee rose to assault the school Party committee and put forth the combat call of "bombarding the School Party Committee and burning Yu Chiang (0060/3068) and Shih Yun-feng (0670/7189/1496)," this nctorious iron-rod royalist committee, seeing that the situation was unfavorable to them, organized an escapist corps, that is, the Red Long-March Corps, and ran away, leaving the more than two hundred people of the former Preparatory Committee in the school. After a brave struggle, the broad masses of revolutionary teachers and students of the Provincial Committee dragged out Yu Chiang, the black secretary, cn 9 November. He was a back-stage boss of the former Preparatory Committee. Seeing clearly the orientation of revolution and the nature of the former Preparatory Committee, the overwhelming majority of revolutionary teachers and students unanimously withdrew themselves from the former Preparatory Committee and joined the Provisional Committee. Eventually, some one hundred people remained in the former Preparatory Committee; they were iron-rod royalists. This Red Long-March 2nd Corps was formed by these iron-rod royalists.

With its back-stage boss -- the black school Party committee -dragged out, the former Preparatory Committee tried to steal the files on 23 November (i.e., the "23 November" Incident), but they were caught by the revolutionary teachers and students of the Provisional Committee and were frustrated once again in Sian. On 26 November (i.e., the "26 November" Incident), the lair of the former Preparatory Committee was searched and wrecked. The former Preparatory Committee had no future and was in the danger of being smashed at any moment. However, everything reactionary is the same; if you don't hit it, it won't fall. The extremely small number of persons who stubbornly clung to the bourgeois reactionary line were not reconciled to their failure. They hastily organized this "Red Long-March 2nd Corps" (iron-rod royalist corps), which was launched on 30 November.

While in school, the revolutionary teachers and students of the Provisional Committee dragged out Yu Chiang, black secretary of the school Party committee. They [the reactionaries] directed their spearhead against the broad masses of revolutionary teachers and students of the Provisional Committee. They worked laboriously the whole day to spread rumor and slander, calling us "a handful of persons," "counterrevolutionaries," "rightists" and "rioters," and calling the revolutionary rebel teachers and students of the Provisional Committee names. They hysterically hit the revolutionary provisional committee and stubbornly clung to the bourgeois reactionary line.

The bourgeois reactionary line headed by Liu Shao-ch'i and Teng Hsiao-p'ing has totally collapsed. The Red Long-March Corps of the former Preparatory Committee has been totally frustrated. But, they are not reconciled to their failure. Assuming different guises, the Red Long-March Corps reorganized itself and set up the "Red Literary and Art Rebel Corps," the "Red Flag Combat Corps," ... as well as this iron-rod royalist corps. We must see through their schemes and tricks, urmask their true nature, and must never allow them to use their names to swindle the masses.

Down with the bourgeois royalists!

Down with the latest counterattack by the bourgeois reactionary line!

If the enemy refuses to surrender, we will finish him off!
