## THE NEW PEKING UNIVERSITY

[Following is a translation of an editorial in the Chinese-language daily newspaper, Jen-min Jih-pao, Peiping, 24 August 1966]

Chairman Mao, our most revered and beloved leader, personally inscribed the words "New Peking University" ("Hsin Pei-ta") on the new school bulletin of the university.
