## COMRADE LI CH'UAN-HUA DIES ON "MAY 6" BRAVELY WE SING "INTERNATIONALE" IN MOURNING

On 6 May, in Chengtu, Szechwan, the "Chengtu Industrial Workers Army" which takes direct orders from the small handful of power-holders inside the party who follows a capital line provoked a large and bloody riotous fight in the 132 Factory in Chengtu. Comrade Yang Yu-chung (2799 7183 1813) reported the news from Chengtu and indicted Li Ching-ch'uan and his likes for their a trocities. He also praised the revolutionary fighters for their courageous struggle. Then, Chairman Wang Ta-pin of the Revolutionary Committee of the Tung-fang Hung Commune spoke on behalf of the Revolutionary Committee. With deep grief he said: "With his life and blood Comrade Li Ch'uan-hua carried out his pledge to defend Chairman Mao until death. He is an example for all the Tung-fang Hung fighters and all the revolutionary comrades. Physically Comrade Li Ch'uan-hua died. But his revolutionary spirit and de-"The martyrs' blood dication to defend Chairman Mao ever remain." must not be shed in vain. The debt of blood must be repaid in blood. We will not give up until Liu Shao-chi, Teng Hsiao-ping, Li Chingch uan and the small handful of power holders inside the party who follow a capitalist line are all smashed."

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Comrade Wang Ta-pin's speech was repeatedly interupted by the excited slogan shouting of the masses at the rally.

The rally observed three minutes" silence to mourn the brave martyrs of the "May 6" incident in Chengtu.

The rally passes the mourning notice issued by the Revolutionary Committee of the Tung-fang Hung Commune, and the condolences telegram sent by the Revolutionary Committee to the Revolutionary Rebels in Chengtu, Szechwan.
