SHANGHAI RED GUARD ORGANIZATION CREATED

[Text] A unified revolutionary organization of Red Guards from Shanghai middle schools has come into being during the excellent great proletarian cultural revolution situation wherein victory after victory has been achieved. The eve of 1968 portends more and greater victories to come. On 30 December the Red Guard Congress of Shanghai middle schools was successfully held at the Cultural Revolution Square. This was an oath-taking rally of Red Guards from middle schools in Shanghai city. It manifested the unity and militancy of the Red Guards and the progressive development and consolidation of the revolutionary great alliance of Red Guards. It definitely impelled proletarian education revolution in middle schools a big step forward.

Comrade Chang Chun-chiao attended the rally. Also present were leading members of the Shanghai municipal revolutionary committee, responsible persons of army, navy, and air force units stationed in Shanghai, and representatives of revolutionary mass organizations.

Comrade Chang Chun-chiao spoke at the rally. First, he extended warm congratulations to the rally on behalf of the Shanghai municipal revolutionary committee and PIA units stationed in Shanghai. He said Red Guards and revolutionary workers, together with revolutionaries from various fronts in Shanghai, under the personal concern and support of the great leader Chairman Mao have won merits in the great proletarian cultural revolution.

However, the revolutionary tasks of the Red Guards are by no means completed. Red Guards must follow Chairman Mao's instructions and carry the great proletarian cultural revolution through to the end. A vitally important task currently confronting the Red Guards is the resolute implementation of Chairman Mao's instruction to resume classes and make revolution. In line with the spirit of reforming as one teaches, they must sweep aside all obstacles and break open a path for proletarian education revolution.

The activities of middle school Red Guards should center on the scholls.
