VICTORY OF REVOLUTION MIRRORED IN MAO'S CALL

In the New Year's Day editorial jointly written by PEOPLE'S DAILY, RED FLAG, and LIBERATION ARMY DAILY, the proletarian headquarters headed by Chairman Mao has issued a great, new battle call to the whole party, the whole army, and the proletarian revolutionaries and the people throughout the country: "Usher in all-round victory of the great proletarian cultural revolution."

They are a beacon light guiding the whole party, the whole army, and the people of the whole country in their heroic onward march, and a most powerful ideological weapon guaranteeing all-round victory in the great proletarian cultural revolution.

Chairman Mao teaches us: "It is necessary to master Marxist theory and apply it, mastering it for the sole purpose of applying it."

The task of prime importance confronting us in the new year is to exert ourselves to achieve the all-round implementation of each and every one of Chairman Mao's latest instructions. Each and every one of them must be implemented in every area, on every front, and in every unit. Once they are mastered by the broad masses of revolutionary people themselves, they will result in conscious revolutionary action on the part of the people in their hundreds of millions and release a great, inexhaustible material force. Strenuous struggle will be needed for their implementation. On the one hand, desperate opposition from the class enemy must be smashed; on the other, struggle must be waged against bourgeois and petty-bourgeois ideas of all stripes within the revolutionary ranks.

In implementing Chairman Mao's latest instructions we must never forget the class energy. We absolutely cannot think that because decisive victory has been won in the great proletarian cultural revolution, everything is all right and we can sleep soundly on a soit pillow, free from care and anxiety. In the new situation where we are striving to win all-round victory in the great proletarian cultural revolution, the handful of renegades and secret agents hiding in the revolutionary ranks, the handful of capitalist-roaders in the party who stubbornly refuse to repent, the ghosts and monsters (i.e. landlords, rich peasants, counterrevolutionaries, bad elements, and rightists who are not yet sufficiently remolded), and the U.S. imperialists, Soviet revisionists and their lackeys will inevitably struggle desperately against us.

They play various underhand and cunning tricks in fabricating rumors and spreading slander to sow dissension. They take advantage of the bourgeois and petty-bourgeois factionalism displayed by some people in our ranks to set one section of the masses against another and to blur class lines. They also vigorously fan up the evil wind of counterrevolutionary economism, engage in profiteering and speculation, and plot to undermine our socialist economy.

In short, they use every means in their vain attempt to undermine Chairman Mao's great strategic plan and to hinder the all-round implementation of his latest instructions. We must pay constant attention to the new trends of activity engaged in by the class enemy, make a serious analysis of the new situation and the special new features of the class struggle, and maintain high revolutionary vigilance.

The struggle between proletarian and bourgeois ideas and between the proletarian and bourgeois world outlooks will inevitably sharpen in the course of the all-round implementation of Chairman Mao's latest instructions. As is stated in the New Year's Day editorial: "As the revolution advances, it touches people deeper and deeper to the very core of their being, and the conflict between proletarian devotion to the public interest and bourgeois self becomes increasingly marked."
