Is their kind of bourgeois and petty-bourgeois factionalism, anarchist ideological trend, and counterrevolutionary evil wind of economism in harmony with the extreme left or right ideological trend emerging (?at present)? Are not those persons who want to see the collapse of the bourgeois headquarters, a bankrupt bourgeois reactionary line, and a heavily attacked revisionist line on party-building, vainly attempting to keep intact the old ideology, style of work, and tradition?

Our comrades would be foolish if they failed to see the acute, complicated, and fierce life-and-death class struggle taking place in the rectification of the party organization. It would also be foolish for them to promote "peaceful" rectification; they would only win the applause of the class enemies.

Confronted with this class struggle, the broad masses of communists and revolutionaries are holding high the great red banner of Mao Tse-tung's thought to take the initiative in launching an offensive against the enemies.
