

NIEH YUAN-TZ'U STABBED DURING ARMED STRUGGLE

On the evening of 28 March, a small handful of evil ringleaders from Peking University's "Ching-kang-shan," under order from their black backstage bosses, collectively and deliberately instigated a large-scale armed struggle. This is an extremely serious political incident in which these ringleaders of Peking University's "Ching-kang-shan" have directly opposed the Central Committee, opposed the Central Committee's Cultural Revolution Group, pointed the sword at the proletarian headquarters, and disrupted the great strategic plan of Chairman Mao.

At around 7:00 A.M. on 29 March, Peking Revolutionary Committee Vice Director and Peking University Cultural Revolution Committee Director Nieh Yuan-tz'u, accompanied by Comrade Li Chung-ch'i [2621/6945/1142], went to the most violent area of the armed struggle in order to stop the fighting. A "Ching-kang-shan" thug carrying an iron pipe and a long spear rushed toward Comrade Nieh Yuan-tz'u, while another counterrevolutionary murderer carrying a dagger stabbed Comrade Nieh Yuan-tz'u in the back of her head. Fresh blood poured over Comrade Nieh Yuan-tz'u's body and on Comrade Li Chung-ch'i's hands and right leg. A PLA soldier who tried to stop [the incident] was stabbed in the hand, and at the same time Comrade Li Chung-ch'i was also injured.

This is a murderous and extremely serious counterrevolutionary incident. In accordance with the "6 June" order and with the four-point resolution of the Peking Garrison Command, the Peking University Cultural Revolution Committee specially issues the following order for arrest:

1. Those who committed this crime and their backstage bosses must immediately give themselves up to the University Cultural Revolution Protection Team. Otherwise, the crime will be considered more serious.

2. The "Ching-kang-shan" General Headquarters must immediately hand over those who committed this crime and their backstage bosses, and not allow them to be concealed or transferred. Otherwise, it will receive punishment under the proletarian dictatorship.

3. We appeal to the vast proletarian revolutionary groups to **act** urgently in assisting us to arrest and bring to court the murderous counter-revolutionary criminals and their backstage bosses who stabbed Comrade Nieh Yuan-tz'u and wounded Comrade Li Chung-ch'i.

Severely punish the murderous counterrevolutionary criminals! Long live the proletarian dictatorship!
